



LABELLING OF THE PLANTS AT THE "JARDIN BOTANIQUE DU PÈRE DELAVAY" (BOTANICAL GARDEN)

Named after a botanist from Les Gets whose research in China over 150 years ago, contributed to the discovery of new plant species. His life's work allowed him to send 200,000 plants to the Natural History Museum in Paris, 1,800 of which were unknown at the time. The name "Delavay" has since been attributed to numerous plants: Rhododendron, Incarvillea (Incarvillae Delavayi), Aster, Osmanthus, Paeonia (peony, Paeonia Delavayi), Osmanthus, Magnolia Delavayi...

As a tribute to his work and discoveries, a botanical garden was created in the natural setting of the Lac des Ecoles. It is open to the public and is an opportunity to go for a walk, learn about the various plants, and awaken the senses, for a unique learning experience.

The particularity and dynamism of this collection of plants found in the garden led to its labelling by the CCVS (the French National Council for the Conservation of Plants and Gardens); an exceptional recognition of intangible cultural heritage.

The Les Gets resort has been organising competitions for nearly 30 years and has been named "Terre de Jeux 2024", the resort is a world-class mountain biking area. Today it is a European benchmark, with an exceptional Bikepark, an extraordinary playground spread over the 128km of marked trails, including specially-adapted ones for e-bikes, and facilities for every level of ability. On the sporting front, the resort is back on the world MTB circuit in full force, as a destination on the UCI calendar. After the tremendous success of the World Cup last July, with 100,000 spectators in total, other important events will put Les Gets in the spotlight. So, the best bikers on the planet will compete against each other once again during the World Cup for this sport from 18th to 20th September 2020. And in 2022, for the second time since 2004, the resort will put all of its expertise into the organisation of the UCI Mountain Bike Mercedes-Benz World Cup. Many are the champions who, having ridden along the Les Gets tracks, have felt intense emotions and a connection with the public like nowhere else. The resort has a special relationship with mountain bikers, especially the athletes who have distinguished themselves at the highest level. From Julien Absalon and Fabien Barel, who have both left their mark on the history of their sport, to Loïc Bruni and Pauline Ferrand-Prévot, who dominate the winners' podiums today, all have been ambassadors of the brand and have worn the colours of the resort with great pride. The national French team has also chosen the Les Gets resort on a number of occasions, for their altitude acclimatisation courses.

BIKEPARK OPENING DATES

It is a magnificent playground for all disciplines including downhill mountain biking, cross-country, freestyle, freeride and electric mountain biking.

In teams of 4 to 8 people, bikers will aim to cycle the most kilometres in order to collect the most donations. The loop will follow the legendary route of the MTB World Cup Cross-Country races, and the future 2022 World Championships.

The competition is open to all types of bike, from traditional mountain bikes to electric bikes. Each kilometre cycled during the weekend will increase the funds donated to the two charities: Pierre Colonge - Mountain Brothers and The Ellie Soutter Foundation.

The event is not focused on physical performance but on the fun of participating, whatever your level. It will be a festive weekend, livened up with lots of entertainment, fun activities in the village, concerts, introductory sessions, balance bike race, conferences, film showings, etc...

PROTECT OUR MOUNTAIN ENVIRONMENT

Both a winter and summer resort, Les Gets offers facilities and services for tourists. The town has been actively participating in sustainable tourism for many years, and aims to launch new projects in order to limit the impact of leisure activities on the environment. Here are some examples of eco-friendly transport initiatives, energy, nature, heritage...:

- Intra and inter-urban shuttles, small train, antipollution Euro 6 buses, GTL gas-powered buses, transport on demand (night-time shuttle...), journey planning with the Pysae app.
- Charging stations throughout the village and ski area for electric cars and mountain bikes.
- 30 GetsLib' in summer, self-service electric bikes.
- 20% off the winter day pass and reserved places for skiers equipped with an electric car.
- Motorbike trials and electric snowmobile for children in Summer or Winter, electric mountain bike rental in sports shops, creation of tracks especially reserved for electric mountain biking.
- Awarded the "Accueil Vélo" label by Les Gets Tourisme.
- Wood-fired boiler supplying 13 municipal buildings.
- Distribution of pocket ashtrays at the cash desk.
- Litter-picking day.
- Eco-friendly golf.
- Protection of the Black Grouse habitat.
- Classification of the Plateau de Loëx as a Natura 2000 site.
- Preservation of natural spaces and redevelopment of wetlands.
- Member of the Geopark Chablais, listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO (protected geological site). The resort has an educational trail at the Lac des Ecoles: the Tourbière des Boittets.

PRICELESS CULTURAL HERITAGE

In the age of new technologies, paper music rolls are resisting! The Les Gets resort is home to the "Musée de la Musique Mécanique", the only one of its kind in Europe. The collection of 800 instruments, some dating back to the 17th century, are all still in working order, much to the delight of the 35,000 visitors each year. It's the 4th most visited museum in the Haute-Savoie area.

The prestigious collection includes:

 The Aeolian Organ, listed as a Historical Monument which still works both automatically and manually, found

at the Les Gets church.

- The automatons of the famous perfume company, Roger & Gallet.
- The mechanical carillon used at the 150th anniversary of the annexation of Savoie to France.
