Introduction to the village

Les Gets is situated in the south-east of France, in the department of Haute-Savoie, in the Northern Alps.



1227 people live in Les Gets all year round.

They are called the Gêtois.

The resort is situated at an altitude of 1172 metres.

In winter, you can ski in the Les Gets-Morzine ski area.

It is part of the Portes du Soleil ski area, one of the largest in the world.

In summer, it's a popular destination for mountain bikers.

Les Gets has organised a number of world mountain bike events:

- The Mountain Bike World Cup Finals in 2019, 2020 and 2021
- The World Championships in 2022.

There are plenty of other activities to discover all year round!

Transports

There are a number of ways to get around the village:

• "Les Gets Bus" shuttle buses

2 bus routes run every hour.

They are free of charge.

• The little train

In the mornings, heritage outings are organised.

Registration at the tourist office or at the ski lift ticket office and presentation of the Multipass are compulsory.

Young people under 16 only need to register.

In the afternoon, the little train runs free of charge.

It runs from the centre of the village to the school lake.

• GetsLib'

These **electrically-assisted bicycles** are available for hire from May to November.

You can start from a number of different locations:

-Maison des Gets (Tourist Office)

-Vieux Village

-Parking du Marais

-Lac des Écoles

-La Fruitière des Perrières

-La Turche

-La route des Chavannes (La Culaz)

-La route du Rocher

You need to register online to obtain a one-time use code.

Paid transport is available to visit the surrounding area:

• The Balad'Aulps Bus

It runs every day in the Vallée d'Aulps (Morzine, Montriond, etc.).

• Jacquet Autocars

The Y92 line takes you to Taninges, Cluses or Morzine all year round.

• SAT

The Y91 line serves the villages of Morzine, Montriond, Saint Jean d'Aulps and Thonon-les-Bains all year round.

• Taxis and transporters

A list is available from the Tourist Office reception.

• Electric vehicles

Charging points are available at various locations:

-Pic car park, 16 rue de Pressenage

-Village centre, in front of the Skilove shop, 18 rue de la forge

-Perrières car park, Route des Pesses

Les Gets in summer

There are plenty of activities to try out in summer:

• Mountain biking

Les Gets' bikepark is one of the largest in Europe.

A bikepark is an area where you can ride your bike in several different ways:

- -Downhill mountain biking (DH)
- -Enduro mountain biking (XC)
- -Electrically assisted mountain biking...

3 lifts give you access to 128 km of marked mountain bike trails:

-The Express chairlifts at Les Chavannes and Les Nauchets from 13th June to 14th September

-The Mont-Chéry cable car from 20th June to 31st August

Les Gets bike area is linked to the Portes du Soleil bike area.

In the village you will find :

-specialist shops to hire or repair your bike

-a dozen instructors for accompanied mountain bike outings

-bike washing areas

-free maintenance and repair points at the chairlifts.

The UCI Mountain Bike World Cup will take place from 28th to 31st August

3 events are on the programme:

- The XCC: Cross-country Short Track on Friday 29th August
- The DHI: Downhill Individual on 30th August
- The XCO: Cross-country Olympic on 31st August
 - The race bike

Les Gets is located on the prestigious Route des Grandes Alpes.

Several legendary passes surround the village:

- -Col de Joux Plane
- -Col de la Ramaz
- -Col de Joux verte
- -Col de l'Encrenaz

• The golf course

The 18-hole golf course allows you to enjoy 18 exceptional panoramic views overlooking Mont Blanc.

On site:

-a golf school

-a pro shop to buy golf equipment

-a restaurant

• Ecoles' swimming lake

This leisure area is equipped with:

-A large beach and supervised swimming area,

-a barbecue

-a wibit park (inflatable water games),

-multi-sports and beach volleyball pitches,

-pump-track

-table tennis...

It is **open from Saturday 28 June to Sunday 31 August** from 12pm to 6.30pm.

• The trail

The circuits are accessible by the Mont Chéry cable car:

- -2 signposted trail walks
- -1 introductory loop for all the family

All routes start and finish at the Mont Chéry arrival station.

Other routes are available in the Portes du Soleil.

White water sports

4-season activities

• 4-season sled on rails

It is accessible to children aged 3 and over, accompanied by an adult.

Children under 8 and under 1m35 in height must be accompanied by an adult over 16.

The start is at Les Perrières, near the chairlift departure point.

• Alta Lumina

Alta Lumina is a nocturnal journey of sound and light.

Tickets can only be purchased online at <u>https://www.altalumina.com/en/</u>

A free shuttle bus runs from the Perrières and Market car parks to Alta Lumina 30 minutes before each show.

• The Mechanical Music Museum

You'll discover a collection of 900 mechanical instruments.

The guided tour will allow you to listen to some of them and see them in action.
