At a Glance

WELCOME TO LES GETS!

At the entrance to the vast Portes du Soleil ski area, Les Gets is a charming, family-friendly and authentic village. Perched at 1,172 metres on a sun-drenched pass, this expansive outdoor playground offers a unique topography spread across two distinct slopes: Mont Chéry on one side and Les Chavannes on the other, placing the village at the very heart of the ski area. Each side offers breathtaking views of Mont Blanc and the Chablais peaks, with an environment that combines family fun and sporting spirit.

The resort has long been a place where families and friends come together, generation after generation. The shared love of winter sports and warm moments makes Les Gets an unforgettable favourite.

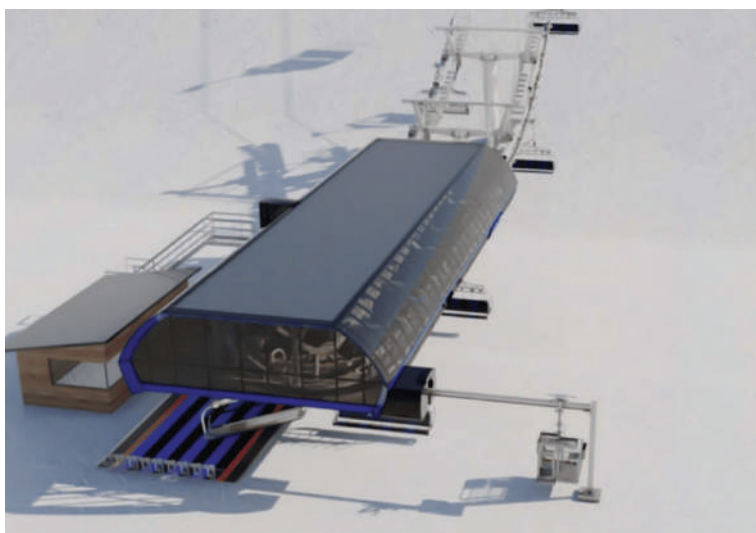
SKI AREA

ROSTA CHAIRLIFT

From December 2025, Solegets, the company that manages the ski area, will be investing in a brand-new detachable chairlift in the Rosta sector. This new lift will replace the old 4-seater chairlift and will be fitted with 8-seater ergonomic chairs and a loading conveyor belt for easier boarding.

The aim is to ease flow on the slopes while offering skiers a faster, more comfortable ride. With an **operating speed of 6 metres per second**, the lift will take skiers to the summit in under three minutes.

A modern and more sustainable technology: thanks to its Direct Drive motor, the lift is part of a more environmentally respectful approach. This technology reduces energy consumption, limits noise pollution and eliminates the use of hydrocarbons, while also enhancing safety for the technical teams who operate it.



Idea for a story: Biodiversity and development: environmental expertise in Les Gets.

Before undertaking any improvement project in the ski area, Les Gets ski lift company (Solegets) calls in an external consultancy to assess the ecological and environmental impacts. For the Chéry development project, Charles and Mathys survey the areas in order to analyse potential impacts and propose specific measures based on their observations. The process involves compiling a year-round inventory of fauna and flora, and identifying the habitats most at stake in terms of biodiversity and landscape.

EVENT

1ST SKI FESTIVAL: THE FESTIVAL OF FIRST TRACKS

From March 21 to 28, 2026

Designed for those who have never strapped on skis before, the 1st Ski Festival offers a week of initiation into the joys of skiing in a friendly, welcoming atmosphere. Reserved for beginners, this unique event brings together participants keen to try their hand at winter sports.

On the programme: ski lessons every morning with instructors from Les Gets ski schools, fun and sporting activities in the afternoon and shared evening meals to build connections. The whole experience is about discovery, with no pressure and no competition—everyone is a beginner!

The package includes all equipment (skis, boots, and poles), ski lessons, Les Gets ski pass, afternoon activities and discounts in partner shops for the event.

Transport and meals are not included in the price. Accommodation at preferential rates is available with the festival's partner establishments.

A VILLAGE ON THE SLOPES

Nestled at 1,172 metres, Les Gets is a mid-mountain resort offering the charm of a village alongside the activities of a larger ski resort. With ski-in/ski-out access, the ski area and its two slopes are just a short walk from the village.



THE VILLAGE AT THE HEART OF THE SKI AREA

Les Gets stands out thanks to its unique layout: a village located right at the centre of the ski area. At its heart, the church and the lanes of the old village highlight the resort's heritage. Situated on a pass in a "cold pocket", the resort benefits from a microclimate that guarantees snow quality comparable to sites perched at 1,500 metres. Free of steep slopes or rock barriers, its gentle terrain ensures smooth, accessible skiing that appeals to families and beginners as well as experienced skiers seeking technical variety.

On one side, the **Les Chavannes slope**, linked to Morzine, is the gateway to the vast Portes du Soleil ski area. This iconic Alpine sector attracts visitors both for its direct access to wide open spaces and its historic lifts, such as the Boule de Gomme drag lift or the Les Chavannes gondola with its typical red cabins. It is also on this slope that the resort's highest point stands: the Ranfoilly, featuring its "Step into the void" platform overlooking Mont Blanc.

Opposite, **Mont Chéry** offers breathtaking views of the entire Mont Blanc range. This slope provides a wilder, quieter environment away from the bustle. More challenging runs, spectacular views and exceptional sunshine on its southern aspect make it a must for adventurous skiers.



SKI TOURING: BREATHTAKING ALPINE EXCURSIONS

From the village of Les Gets, four ski touring routes are available, suitable for all levels. Ski touring routes allow a moment of escape in complete autonomy. Whatever route is chosen, a ski touring outing in Les Gets promises panoramic views of the Mont Blanc range and unforgettable memories. For the more adventurous, numerous guides offer trips off the beaten track for a wilder discovery of the ski area.

UNFORGETTABLE FAMILY EXPERIENCES

DOG SLEDDING: INUIT EXPERIENCE

On the Mont Chéry side, departing from the hamlet of Lassare, the Patte Nordic sled team is ready to go. Justine, a 28-year-old qualified musher, offers a unique experience in Les Gets: the Inuit Experience, an immersion into the Nordic world of the Inuits. Harnessed to the sled, the dogs race along, giving participants a thrilling experience. A delightful snack break comes halfway through: a moment to toast with a hot drink alongside your canine companions. The return takes place in the early evening under the light of the Moon and stars.

Couple/duo option: maximum two people per sled.

SNOWSHOEING: SUNRISE SERENITY & SUNSET MAGIC

Snowshoe outings follow routes overlooking the resort. With departures at dawn or dusk, iconic spots such as Mont Caly, Mont Chéry and Les Chavannes appear in a completely different, more intimate light. Reconnect with nature while witnessing a sunrise or sunset over the Mont Blanc massif. Using headlamps, each outing becomes a unique spectacle. Special moments are accompanied by either a breakfast snack or an aperitif featuring local products. Approximately 3 hours.

LES GETS, A PIONEERING RESORT

The oldest drag lift in the resort is celebrating its 90th anniversary. The Boule de Gomme lift, with its saying "Qui souvent la Boule de Gomme montera, champion de ski deviendra" (Who often rides the Boule de Gomme will become a ski champion), has inspired young skiers and made life easier for adults. On the back of this success, Les Gets was the first resort in France to unveil a prototype chairlift...



HERITAGE: a technological revolution in the ski industry! Les Gets became the first resort in France to adapt a drag lift by adding seats, paving the way for the earliest designs of the modern chairlift.



Destination of Excellence

A MORE RESPONSIBLE TOURISM LABEL

In July 2025, Les Gets was awarded the Destination d'Excellence label, which aims to raise standards across the entire tourism offer — accommodation, restaurants, visitor and leisure attractions, tourist information services and transport. In addition to ensuring the quality of welcome and services, the label also strengthens commitments to eco-responsibility.

Les Gets is the second resort in France to receive this label!

LES GETS: THE "ELEGANT" FACE OF PORTES DU SOLEIL

Les Gets combines the elegance of a major resort with the authenticity of a preserved Haute-Savoie village. Only a few kilometres from the railway stations and Geneva International Airport, Les Gets stands out for both its accessibility and its Alpine charm.

BEYOND BORDERS

In Portes du Soleil, one ski pass erases all borders. Twelve resorts—eight in France (Les Gets, Morzine, Avoriaz, Montriond, Saint-Jean-d'Aulps, Châtel, Abondance, La Chapelle d'Abondance) and four in Switzerland (Torgon, Morgins, Champéry, Champoussin/Les Crosets)—are linked by lifts. Summit after summit reveals spectacular panoramas, from the majestic Mont Blanc to the Dents du Midi and the sparkling waters of Lake Geneva. Here, every run brings a change of scenery, a new atmosphere... and sometimes even a different country. With so many connections, there is no room for monotony on these slopes.



A journey within a journey: Skiing in Portes du Soleil is more than a sport; it is a way of exploring landscapes and savouring Alpine traditions. From Les Gets, the adventure begins with a breathtaking view of Mont Blanc from the summit of Ranfoilly, the highest point in the area. The journey continues beyond the French border through Avoriaz, with its striking architecture, before ending in Morgins with a well-deserved taste of Swiss fondue.

LES SOURCES DU CHÉRY

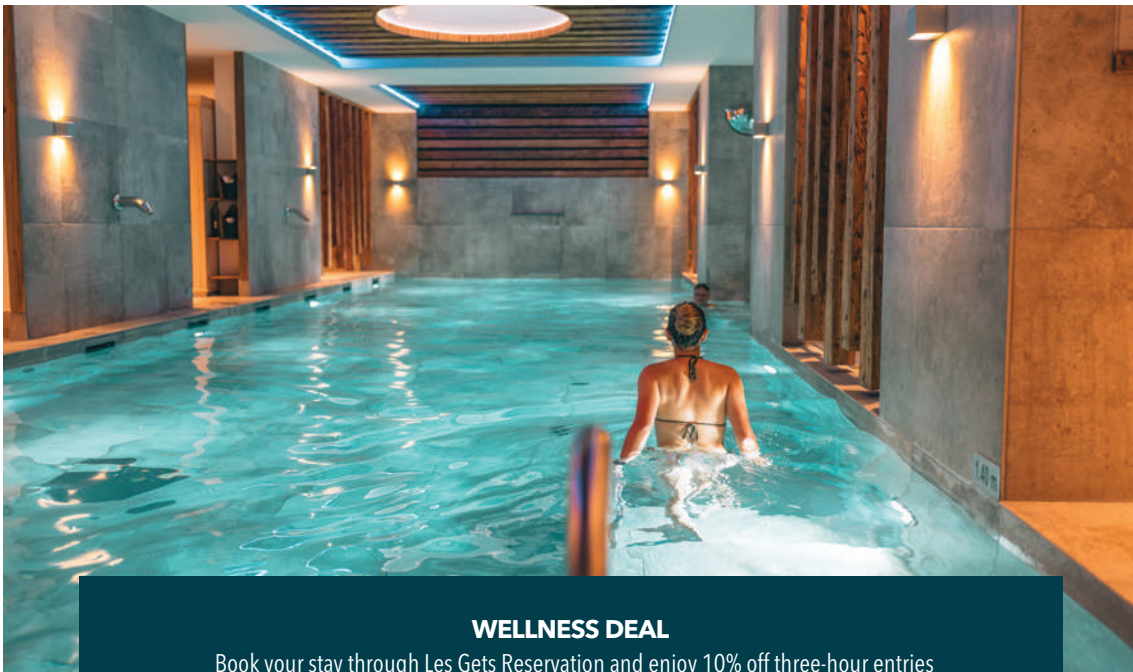
A WEEKEND ESCAPE

TO WILDLIFE

PROTECTING THE BLACK GROUSE

Among Les Gets' conservation initiatives is the protection of local wildlife, particularly the black grouse, a protected species emblematic of the Alps. At this time of year, their survival is threatened by the severe cold and scarce food resources. The birds are especially sensitive to disturbance, as they cannot afford to expend energy leaving their shelter prematurely when skiers venture off-piste or snowshoers pass by.

Measures have been put in place on Mont Chéry and at the summit of Ranfoilly: wintering areas are now clearly marked with information panels to raise awareness among off-piste skiers, and the cables of the "Express Ranfoilly" lift, as well as the four lifts on Mont Chéry, have been made more visible with bird markers to prevent potentially fatal collisions.

As part of its weekly programme, Les Gets also runs activities to educate the public on preserving the mountain environment, including wildlife protection and general mountain conservation.

ON THE SKI AREA

WOODEN SKI PASSES

Three years ago, the resort introduced a novel initiative: a range of beechwood ski passes to replace plastic passes (40,000 plastic passes were issued to skiers and mountain bikers each year).



***Did you know?** Les Gets was also the first resort in Europe to ban smoking on its slopes. This public health and environmental measure underlines its reputation as a progressive and forward-thinking resort on social and ecological issues.*



ACCESSIBILITY

SUSTAINABLE MOBILITY: SHUTTLES AND TRANSPORT

Transport accounts for nearly 75% of tourism-related greenhouse gas emissions, and the resort is committed to promoting responsible travel.

At the heart of the village, a network of free shuttles ensures easy access to key locations, including more outlying areas. All Les Gets vehicles run on Oleo100, a renewable fuel made from French-grown rapeseed. This choice reduces greenhouse gas emissions by 60%.

Beyond the village, regular inter-resort connections make travel easier, with a direct link to Cluses railway station.

A strategic choice, considering that transport between home and holiday destination alone accounts for 68% of the sector's emissions.

SMART TIP: TRAVEL BY TRAIN AND SAVE!

Montagne Verte, a local association operating in the Les Gets-Morzine area, works towards a low-carbon future. The association offers the AlpinExpress pass, which gives discounts on accommodation, ski rental, lessons, restaurants and more, for those arriving by train.

AT OUR LOCAL SHOPS

LE GALTA: SECOND-HAND WITH STYLE

A new concept store, Le Galta is much more than a typical boutique: it is a hybrid space where the past meets creativity. Founded by Ingrid, a passionate vintage hunter and experienced stylist, the shop offers four complementary services: a second-hand clothing and objects store, a sewing service, an upcycling workshop and interior design guidance.

Every item on display is chosen for its story and carefully transformed. Here, an old shirt becomes a unique creation, armchairs are given a new lease of life, and flea-market finds blend seamlessly into the mountain-chalet atmosphere of the local area.

Le Galta also wins over other local businesses: for example, the Chalet du Lac restaurant entrusted Ingrid with creating a hot-air-balloon-shaped chandelier, a poetic nod to the world of Alta Lumina.

Fun fact: in the Haute-Savoie dialect, a galta refers to an attic or storage space!

ALTA LUMINA

In the heart of the forest, blanketed in snow at night, a one-kilometre illuminated trail with immersive scenes awaits visitors. The story of a travelling musician, tied to the very DNA of the region, invites spectators on a poetic journey through light and sound. Ideal for all ages, this experience is part of the resort's year-round diversification strategy. Self-guided tours last between 50 minutes and 1 hour.

MUSEUM OF MECHANICAL MUSIC

The Museum of Mechanical Music houses a unique collection of over 900 mechanical musical instruments: carillons, automata, clocks, music boxes and many other unusual pieces. This incredible collection is the result of the dedication of a passionate team. One of the most visited museums in Haute-Savoie, it is open year-round. New for 2025, the museum proudly expands its collection with a highlight: Pablo Picasso's mechanical piano! To complement the piano's arrival, author Félix Meynet created a comic book, *Pour une Ballade Mécanique aux Gets*, available for purchase. Allow about two hours to explore the museum.

Open daily from 2:15 p.m. to 7 p.m.

4-SEASON LUGE

Buckle up for an adrenaline rush! Through the larch forest on a 46% slope (reaching speeds of up to 40 km/h!), alone or in pairs, the 4-Season Luge is a rush of adrenaline for the whole family—a perfect alternative to skiing for those seeking even more thrills.

POTTERY

At Poterie des Gets, visitors step into a world where creativity meets traditional craftsmanship. Every piece is unique, shaped with its own identity. On one side, the farm and its sheep; on the other, the creative workshop. Deeply rooted in local inspiration, the motifs draw directly from the mountain and rural atmosphere that surrounds the place.

New for 2025: Nathalie now offers a chance to create a one-of-a-kind keepsake with introductory ceramic decoration workshops every Tuesday. The pieces are glazed and fired on site, ready for collection on Friday.

MOUNTAIN BIKING CAPITAL – EVEN IN WINTER!

In Les Gets, mountain biking is part of the village's DNA, so it is only natural that the activity continues year-round. Several providers offer electric mountain bikes specially designed for snow, known as fat bikes, and organise snow-riding introductions. With their extra-wide tyres, these bikes provide excellent stability on snow. The groomed, secure trails are accessible from age 8 and guided by qualified instructors.
