

# Introduction to the village

**Les Gets** is situated in the south-east of France, in the department of Haute-Savoie, in the Northern Alps.



**1227 people** live in Les Gets all year round.

They are called **the Gêtois**.

The resort is situated at an **altitude of 1172 metres**.

**In winter**, you can ski in the **Les Gets-Morzine ski area**.

It is part of **the Portes du Soleil ski area**, one of the largest in the world.

**In summer**, it's a popular destination for **mountain bikers**.

Les Gets has organised **a number of world mountain bike events**:

- **The Mountain Bike World Cup Finals** in 2019, 2020 and 2021
- **The World Championships** in 2022.

There are **plenty of other activities** to discover all year round!

# Transports

**There are a number of ways to get around the village:**

- **“Les Gets Bus” shuttle buses (summer - winter)**

These shuttles are free of charge.

They run throughout the village.

- **The little train (summer)**

In the morning, heritage tours are organised.

Registration at the tourist office or at the ski lift ticket office and presentation of the Multipass are mandatory.

For young people under 16, only registration is mandatory.

**In the afternoon, the little train runs free of charge.**

It shuttles between the village centre and the school lake.

- **Les GetsLib’ (May to November)**

**These electric bikes are available for hire.**

**You must register online** to obtain a single-use code.

You can **start from different locations:**

-Maison des Gets (Tourist Office)

-Vieux Village

-Parking du Marais

-Lac des Écoles

-La Fruitière des Perrières

-La Turche

-La route des Chavannes (La Culaz)

-La route du Rocher

**and ride on tarmac roads only.**

**Paid transports are available to visit the surrounding area:**

- **The Balad'Aulps Bus (summer - winter)**

It runs every day in the Vallée d'Aulps (Morzine, Montriond, etc.).

- **Les Autocars Jacquet (all year round)**

The Y92 line takes you to Taninges, Cluses or Morzine.

- **SAT (all year round)**

The Y91 line serves the villages of Morzine, Montriond, Saint Jean d'Aulps and Thonon-les-Bains.

- **Taxis and transport companies (all year round)**

A list is available at the tourist office reception desk.

- **Electric vehicles**

Charging points are available at various locations:

-Pic car park, 16 rue de Pressenage

-Village centre, in front of the Skilove shop, 18 rue de la forge

-Perrières car park, Route des Pesses

# Les Gets in summer

There are plenty of activities to try out in summer:

- **Mountain biking**

**Les Gets' bikepark is one of the largest in Europe.**

A bikepark is an area where you can ride your bike in several different ways:

- Downhill mountain biking (DH)
- Enduro mountain biking (XC)
- Electrically assisted mountain biking...

**3 lifts** give you access to 128 km of marked mountain bike trails:

- The Express des Chavannes and Nauchets chairlifts** from 19 June to 13 September 2026
- The Mont-Chéry gondola lift** from 19 June to 30 August 2026

Les Gets bike area is linked **to the Portes du Soleil bike area.**

In the village you will find :

- specialist shops to hire or repair your bike
- instructors for accompanied mountain bike outings
- bike washing areas
- free maintenance and repair points at the chairlifts.

- **The race bike**

Les Gets is located on the prestigious **Route des Grandes Alpes**.

**Several legendary passes surround the village:**

-Col de Joux Plane

-Col de la Ramaz

-Col de Joux verte

-Col de l'Encrenaz

- **Hiking**

**A guide to the hiking trails** is available free of charge from the Tourist Office.

There are **13 hiking trails**:

3 ski lifts are accessible to pedestrians:

- **Mont Chéry gondola lift and Pointe chairlift** on the Mont Chéry slope (uphill and downhill)
- **Chavannes Express chairlift** on the Chavannes slope (uphill only)

- **The golf course**

The 18-hole golf course allows you to enjoy 18 exceptional panoramic views overlooking Mont Blanc.

On site:

- a golf school
- a pro shop to buy golf equipment
- a restaurant

- **Ecoles' swimming lake**

This leisure area is equipped with:

- A large beach and supervised swimming area,
- a barbecue
- a wibit park (inflatable water games),
- multi-sports and beach volleyball pitches,
- pump-track

It is **open from Saturday 27 June to Sunday 30 August 2026.**

- **The trail**

The circuits are accessible by the Mont Chéry cable car:

- 2 signposted trail walks**
- 1 introductory loop** for all the family

All routes start and finish at the **Mont Chéry arrival station**.

Other routes are available in the Portes du Soleil.

- **White water sports**

-Rafting

-Tubing

-Hydrospeed...

- **Paragliding**

- **Protected geological site of the peat bogs, labelled Geopark Chablais UNESCO**

- **Père Delavay Botanical Garden**

Both are located near the Lac des Ecoles.

# Les Gets in winter

There are many activities to try in winter:

- **Downhill skiing**

The Les Gets-Morzine ski area is part of the **Portes du Soleil ski area**.

The ski lifts are **open from 20 December 2025 to 12 April 2026** (partially open since 13 December).

- **Ski touring**

**Four marked and secured ski touring routes** are accessible on the slopes of Mont Chéry and Les Chavannes.

They are accessible for ascents only. Descents must be made on the slopes while they are open.

- **Cross-country skiing**

Les Gets has **marked and secured trails on the slopes of Mont-Chéry and Les Chavannes**.

- **Hiking and snowshoeing**

You can try snowshoeing on the resort's specially designed trails. **A guide is available at the tourist office.**

**If you would like to be accompanied, you can hire a guide or mountain leader.**

- **Snow mountain biking**

Book your tour with a qualified instructor.

- **Dog sled rides**

Solo, as a couple or with the family

And also:

- **Ice rink**
- **Cinema**
- **Bowling**

# 4-season activities

- **4-season sled on rails**

It is **accessible to children aged 3 and over**, accompanied by an adult.

Children under 8 and under 1m35 in height must be accompanied by an adult over 16.

The start is at **Les Perrières**, near the chairlift departure point.

- **Alta Lumina**

Alta Lumina is a nocturnal journey of sound and light.

**Tickets can only be purchased online** at <https://www.altalumina.com/en/>

**A free shuttle bus runs from the Perrières and Market car parks** to Alta Lumina 30 minutes before each show.

- **The Mechanical Music Museum**

You'll discover a collection of **900 mechanical instruments**.

The guided tour will allow you to listen to some of them and see them in action.

- **Wellness activities**

**-2 fitness centres:** Fitlife and Sport'N Chéry

**-Spas:** Les Sources du Chéry, Séréni Cimes and Spa Kinabalu

**-Yoga classes**
