Our goal: to enable everyone to enjoy mountain activities in both summer and winter.

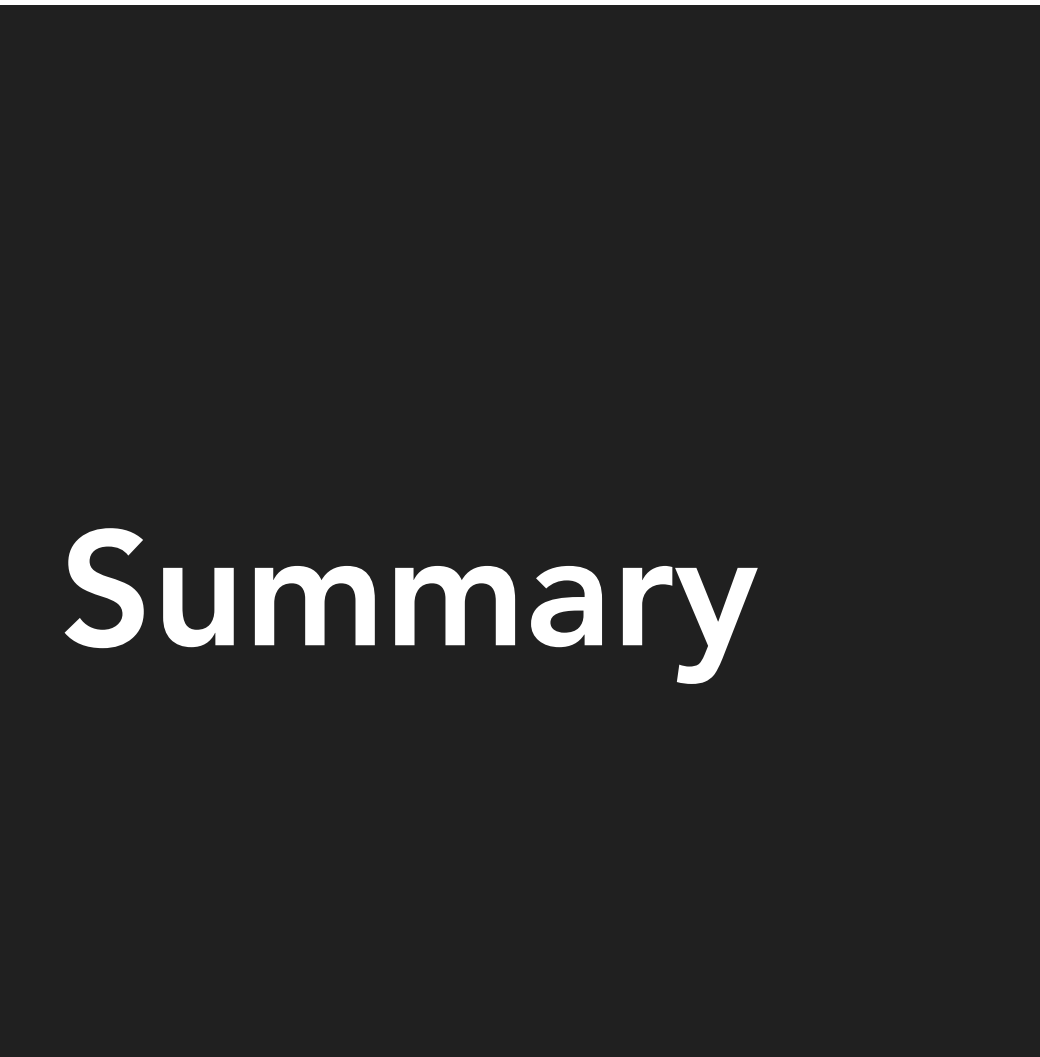
As part of the Tourism & Disability certification process, Les Gets Tourisme has produced this booklet, which details the facilities available to ensure you have a pleasant stay.

Parking

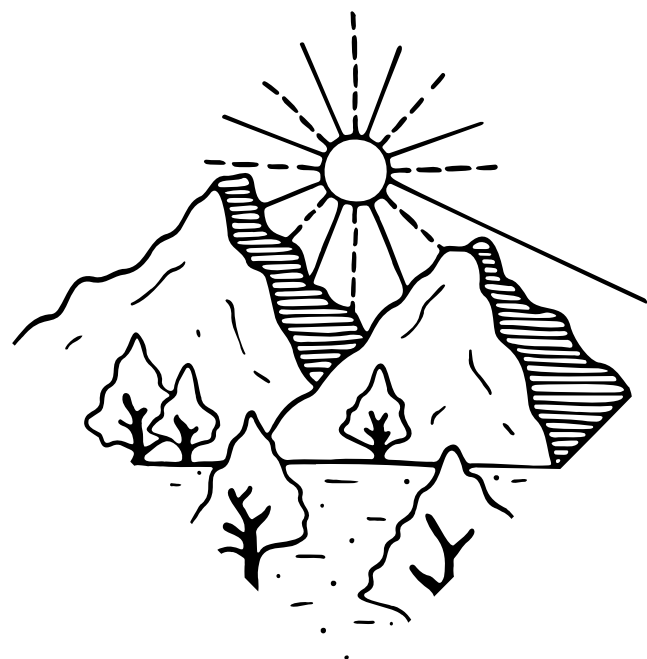
The following car parks have spaces reserved for people with reduced mobility:

- Marais car park (Place du Marché)
- Perrières car park
- Chavannes underground car park (please note that the car park stairs do not have wheelchair access ramps)
- Colombière car park, Pic et Pressenage car parks
- Forge car park
- P'teaux car park
- Pied de l'Adroit car park
- Lac car park
- La Turche car park
- Sommet des Chavannes car park
- Mont Caly car park

Toilets

Adapted toilets are also available at several locations in the resort:

- Caisse Centrale des Chavannes
- Caisse des Perrières
- Tourist Office (in the basement, accessible by lift)
- Caisse de la Turche

Two ski lifts dedicated to mountain biking in Les Gets in summer are approved by the Ministry of Transport:

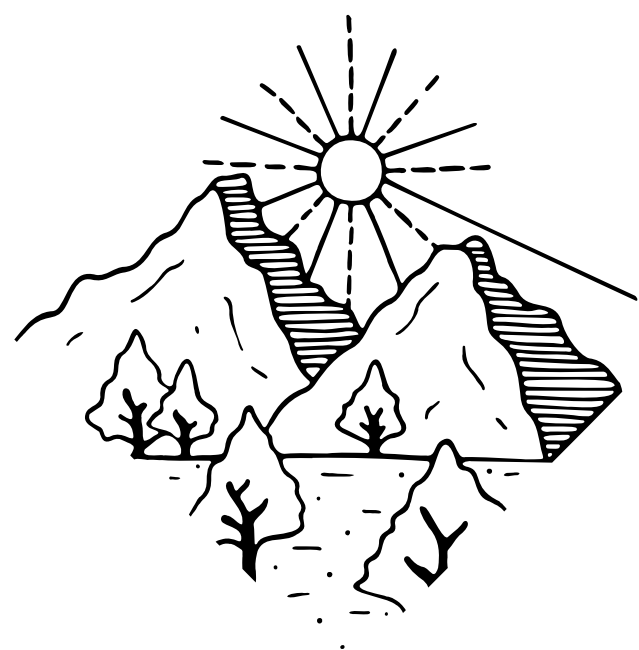

Safety

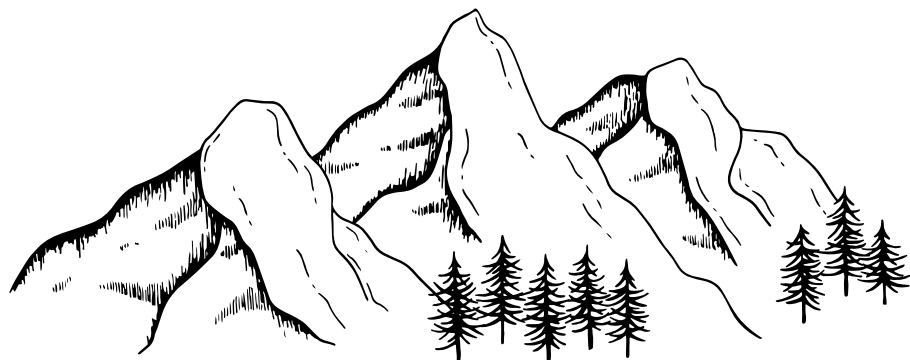
To guarantee you unlimited access to the slopes in Les Gets, please check that your all-terrain wheelchair is approved in accordance with the general conditions of use established by the FTT approval commission (Technical Services for Ski Lifts and Guided Transport + Domaine Skiable de France + French Handisport Federation).

PLEASE NOTE: For safety reasons, any chair that does not meet the FTT's general conditions will be refused access to the ski lifts.

Lift accessibility

- The Mont Chéry gondola lift is accessible to people with disabilities (access to floor G1 by lift) but not to FTTs (cabin size unsuitable).

Same price for accompanying persons depending on the category of person.

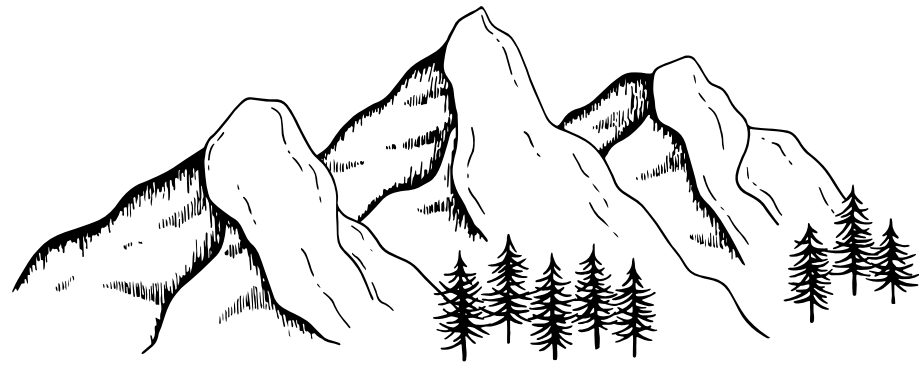
Accessible ski lifts

All ski lifts on the Chavannes and Chéry sides are accessible to disabled skiers, except for the following:

- Chavannes gondola lift
- Mont Chéry gondola lift

due to the size of the gondolas. On the Chéry side, access is closed.
